Dr. Robin Welsch is an Assistant Professor of Engineering Psychology at Aalto University, Finland, where he investigates human-computer interaction, virtual reality, and artificial intelligence. His research explores how people interact with emerging technologies, including work on the "AI ghostwriter effect", examining user perceptions of AI-generated content, and societal attitudes toward human augmentation technologies. He has published in leading venues such as *Computers in Human Behavior* and the CHI Conference on Human Factors in Computing Systems, with research spanning topics from the placebo effect of AI to proxemics in augmented reality and social interactions in virtual environments.
